Legal bases for the OLS Shareholder's Club recruitment campaign

Starting point

Iberdrola, S.A. will hold a promotion with the aim of encouraging shareholder recruitment and loyalty to the OLS Shareholder's Club through a prize draw.

The following are the legal bases (hereinafter "**Legal Bases**") governing the prize draw known as the "OLS Shareholder's Club Recruitment Campaign" (hereinafter the "**Prize Draw**").

1. Organising company.
 - The organising company of the Draw is Iberdrola, S.A. (hereinafter, "Iberdrola"), with registered office at Plaza Euskadi, 5, Bilbao, and Tax Identification Number A-48010615.
2. Purpose of the Draw.
 - The purpose is to raffle a technology kit (hereinafter the "Prize") among all shareholders who have registered as members of the Club before 29 April 2026.
3. Registration period.
 - The registration period for the Draw will begin on 13 March 2026 from the launch of the campaign and will end on 28 April 2026 at 11:59 p.m., after which no further registrations for the Draw will be accepted.
 - Notwithstanding the foregoing, Iberdrola reserves the right to modify the above deadline.
4. Territorial scope.
 - The Draw is exclusively for Spanish nationals.
5. Deposit, accessibility and acceptance of Legal Bases.
 - The Legal Bases of the Draw are published and accessible to all shareholders at the following address [Go to Iberdrola website](#).
 - These Legal Bases are available for consultation at www.iberdrola.com and in the notarial archive of competition and draw legal bases (ABACO) [Go to the Notary website](#).

- Any aspect not covered in these Legal Bases or any doubt regarding their interpretation will be resolved at the discretion of the promotion organisers.
 - Participation in the Draw implies full acceptance of the Legal Bases and full compliance with them.
 - Participation in the Draw necessarily implies acceptance of Iberdrola's interpretative criteria regarding the resolution of any issue arising from the Draw.
 - Participation in the Draw also implies the processing of data in accordance with Annex I on privacy of these Legal Bases.
6. Requirements and mechanics of participation in the Draw.
- In order to participate in the Draw, in addition to being an Iberdrola shareholder, the following requirements must be met:
 - Be of legal age.
 - Be a natural person.
 - Be registered with the Iberdrola OLS Shareholder's Club.
 - You must expressly accept the Legal Bases of the Draw and the Privacy Notice.
 - You may only participate once.
 - In order to participate, Club members must provide their full name, ID number, telephone number, email address and full postal address.
 - If any of the information provided is invalid, participation in the Draw will be cancelled.
 - The Draw before a Notary Public will be held on 11 May and, once the Draw has been held, Iberdrola will contact the winner via the contact channel provided by the participant when registering with the Club (email address or telephone number), sending them the Prize acceptance document.
 - The Notary Public will select 1 winner and 10 alternates from among the participants.

Exclusions.

- Iberdrola reserves the right to remove from the Draw any participant who alters, harms in any way or threatens the proper functioning and normal and regulatory development of the Draw.

- Any participant who, intentionally or unintentionally, harms or damages the image of Iberdrola, its customers or other participants will also be removed.
- Participants who, at the time of the Draw, are no longer shareholders or members of the Club will be removed from the Draw.

7. Description of the Prize.

- Technology kit consisting of an HP 15-fc0243ns laptop with 32 GB RAM, 1 TB SSD and an HP Smart Tank 7007 multifunction printer (with a recommended retail price on the market at the date of €999 for the laptop and €400.90 for the multifunction printer).
- The winning shareholder may not request to exchange the Prize for another prize or for its monetary equivalent, but may waive the Prize, in which case there will be no compensation and the Prize will be awarded to the corresponding substitute.
- The prize is personal and non-transferable.
- In the event of unavailability or force majeure, Iberdrola reserves the right to replace it with another of similar characteristics of equal or greater value.
- Iberdrola is not responsible for any technical problems that may arise in the subsequent operation of the Prize, nor for any costs that may arise as a result.

8. Prize delivery.

- Iberdrola will contact the winning shareholder via the contact channel provided when registering with the Club at the time of entry in the Draw to inform them that they have been selected as the winner, and they will be asked to submit a form with the following details: Name and surname(s), ID number/foreign ID number, telephone number, email address and postal address.
- If the participant's contact channel is by telephone and the winner cannot be located within 48 hours, Iberdrola will contact the next substitute, and if the corresponding substitute cannot be contacted within the same period for up to ten substitutes, the Prize will be declared void.
- Once the winner or substitute has been notified, they will have a non-extendable period of seven (7) calendar days to confirm their acceptance by signing and returning the document sent to them by Iberdrola for this purpose.
- If the winner or the corresponding substitute has not sent the form to Iberdrola within this period, the Prize will be declared void.

- In order for the Prize to be awarded, the winner must sign the Prize acceptance document.
- Iberdrola will publish the winner's name and surname on its communication channels once the above procedure has been completed.

9. Data Protection

- Information on the processing of personal data of participants in the Draw is set out in Annex I to these Legal Bases.

10. Modification of the conditions of the Draw and cancellation

- Iberdrola reserves the right to modify or cancel, without justification and at any time, these Legal Bases and the Draw, which will be published at [Go to Iberdrola website](#).

11. Applicable tax regime

- The prizes in the competition will be subject to current tax legislation, and Iberdrola will be responsible, where applicable, for making the corresponding payment on account or withholding tax for income tax purposes.
- Iberdrola will issue the winning participant with the appropriate withholding certificate so that they can include the value of the prize in their income tax return.
- The winner will be responsible for complying with the tax and accounting obligations associated with receiving the prize for personal tax purposes.

12. Applicable law and jurisdiction

- These Legal Bases shall be interpreted in accordance with Spanish law. For all matters relating to the interpretation, compliance and enforcement of these Legal Bases, Iberdrola and the participating shareholders, expressly waiving any other jurisdiction or privilege that may apply to them, submit to the jurisdiction and competence of the Courts and Tribunals of the city of Bilbao.

ANNEX I

PRIVACY NOTICE

Iberdrola, S.A. and the companies that form part of the Iberdrola Group in accordance with commercial legislation (hereinafter, any of them, "Iberdrola") undertakes to protect your privacy and guarantees compliance with personal data protection legislation, in particular the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and the personal data protection legislation applicable in each country in which the companies of the Iberdrola Group are domiciled. Your personal data will be processed lawfully, fairly and transparently; in accordance with specific, explicit and legitimate purposes; only if it is adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to those purposes. In addition, we will keep your data accurate and up to date, storing it in a way that allows you to be identified only for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purposes of the processing.

Iberdrola has implemented the necessary technical and organisational measures to protect your data from accidental loss or alteration, unauthorised access, use or disclosure, and has also established procedures to respond to any security incident that may affect your personal data.

Through this privacy notice, we inform you about how your personal data will be processed in connection with your participation in the prize draw called "OLS Shareholder's Club Recruitment Campaign" (the "**Prize Draw**").

You should read this notice in order to understand the purpose of the processing of personal data and the circumstances surrounding it by Iberdrola.

We will notify you in a timely manner in the event of any changes to this privacy notice.

What personal data do we process and how do we obtain it?

Iberdrola will only process your personal data that is necessary to fulfil the purposes of processing set out below. This includes your first and last names, your national identity number/tax identification number/foreign national identity number, email address, telephone number and, where applicable, postal address. We obtain your personal data directly from you through your registration in the Prize Draw and your registration details as a member of the "OLS Iberdrola Shareholder's Club".

Who is responsible for processing your personal data?

The data controller responsible for processing your personal data is IBERDROLA, S.A., with registered office at Plaza Euskadi 5, 48009 Bilbao and tax identification number A-48010615. Iberdrola has appointed a data protection officer, whom you can contact for any questions regarding this Privacy Policy at the email address dpo@iberdrola.com.

For what purposes do we process your data?

We will process your data for the following purposes:

1. To process your entry in the Prize Draw and verify that you are eligible to participate in accordance with the Legal Bases.
2. To manage your participation in the Prize Draw and the communication, dissemination and delivery of the prize, should you be the winner.

If you are a winner, your first and last names will be published exclusively for informational purposes and for the transparency of the Draw, in accordance with the provisions of the Legal Bases.

What are the legal bases for processing your data?

The legal bases for the processing of your personal data for purposes 1 and 2 is the execution of the legal bases of the Prize Draw, which you accept by participating in the Prize Draw.

How long do we keep your data?

The personal data processed for purposes 1 and 2 will be kept for the period from registration and participation until the end of the Draw.

Once the above periods have expired, the data may be kept, duly blocked, for the period required by law to deal with any legal liabilities, and will be permanently deleted once this period has expired.

Who will your data be communicated to?

Your data may be communicated to third parties and official bodies (i) in compliance with legal obligations; or (ii) to comply with requirements from regulatory, judicial, fiscal (Tax Administration) or other authorities.

However, internal service providers related to IT services, as well as external service providers related to the organisation of the Draw, such as transport companies for the delivery of prizes, may have access to your personal data. Iberdrola has signed the legally required contracts with all of them, under which they guarantee compliance with their obligations as data processors.

No international transfers of your personal data take place.

What are your rights?

You have the right to access your personal data being processed, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, to request its deletion when the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, in addition to exercising your right to object to and restrict the processing and portability of the data.
