



1. RIVER YANGTSÉ (ASIA)

This Chinese river is the largest on the Asian continent and it deposits 330 million kilogrammes of rubbish annually into the sea.

2. RIVER GANGES (ASIA)

This sacred Hindu river carries 120 million kilogrammes of plastic waste annually to the sea after passing through India and Bangladesh.

3. RIVER XI, DONG Y ZHUJIANG (ASIA)

The Zhujiang River and its two tributaries (Dong and Xi) are in third position with 106 million kilogrammes of plastic annually.

4. RIVER CROSS (AFRICA)

This coastal river, which runs through Cameroon and Nigeria, takes with it more than 40 million kilogrammes of plastic, annually.

5. RIVER BRANTAS (ASIA)

This Indonesian river is the longest in East Java and it deposits 38 million kilogrammes of plastic into the sea every year.
