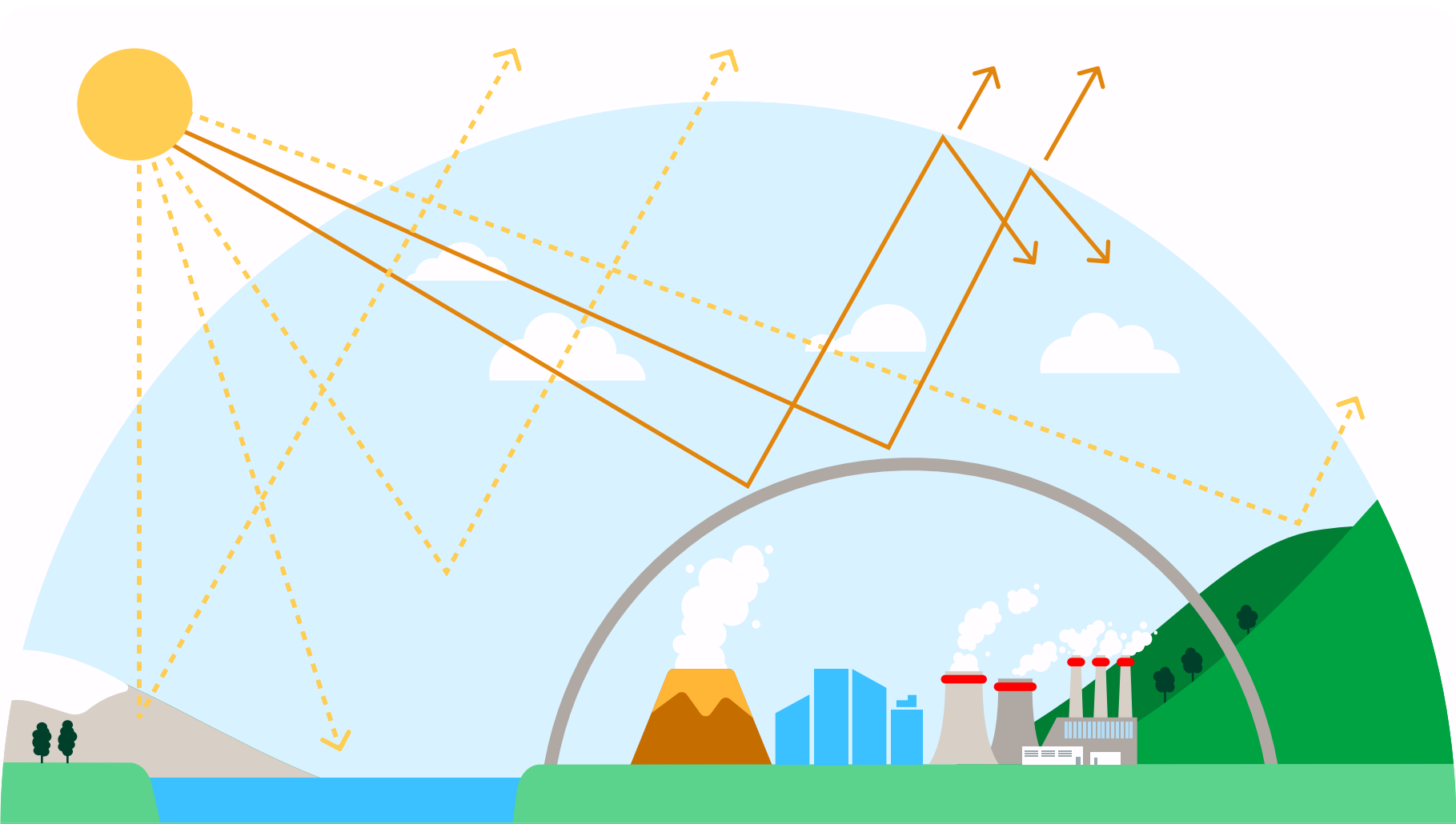


How the greenhouse effect is produced
