
WELCOME TO JAI ALAI!

1977 The Milford Jai Alai court in Connecticut is opened, collecting 470,979 dollars in bets.

1982 John B. Callahan, Chairman of World Jai Alai, is murdered.

1988

600 "pelotaris" start a strike, which will last three years.

Only two Jai Alai courts offer games throughout the year: Miami Jai Alai and Dania Beach Jai Alai. Another five courts have very little activity but make sure that this Basque tradition keeps on going in the United States.
