Eradicate extreme poverty.

Ensure universal access to affordable, reliable and modern energy services.

Increase substantially the share of renewable energy.



Sustain per capita economic growth at least 7 per cent gross domestic product growth per annum in the least developed countries.

Promote development-oriented policies that support productive activities and encourage the growth of micro-, small- and medium-sizes enterprises.



Develop quality, reliable, sustainable and resilient infrastructure.

Increase the access of small-scale industrial and other enterprises to financial services.



Empower and promote the social, economic and political inclusion of all people.

Ensure equal opportunity.



Ensure access for all to adequate, safe and affordable housing and basic services and upgrade slums.

Provide access to safe, affordable, accessible and sustainable transport systems for all, improving road safety.



Achieve the sustainable management and efficient use of natural resources.

Halve per capita global food waste at the retail and consumer levels.



Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate related hazards and natural disasters in all countries.

Integrate climate change measures into national policies, strategies and planning.



Prevent and significantly reduce marine pollution of all kinds.

Sustainably manage and protect marine and coastal ecosystems.



Ensure the conservation, restoration and sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems.

Promote the implementation of sustainable management of all types of forest and halt deforestation.



Reduce all forms of violence and related death rates everywhere.
