

Iberdrola launches its International Master's Scholarship Programme

Today Iberdrola opens a new call for applications for its <u>Master's scholarships for the 2025–2026</u> <u>academic year</u>. When selecting candidates, other factors such as CV, interest in the study project and letters of reference will be taken into account in addition to academic record and language skills.

To date, nearly 1,000 young people have already had the opportunity to boost their professional careers by pursuing master's and postgraduate studies and conducting research at prestigious international centres with the support of the Iberdrola Group. This year's scholarships will be awarded to students of Engineering, Computer Science, Mathematics, Big Data, Cybersecurity, Information and Communication Technologies, Business Administration and Digital Marketing.
