Iberdrola Chairman Ignacio Galán has expressed his delight at supporting the mega-project led by SEAT and the Volkswagen Group, an initiative that further strengthens the collaboration between the two business groups, which sealed an alliance to promote electric mobility in Spain a few months ago. 

Iberdrola is once again putting its resources at the service of economic recovery in Spain.
