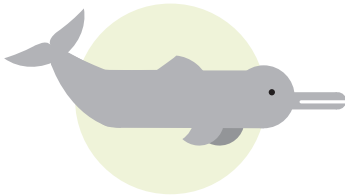

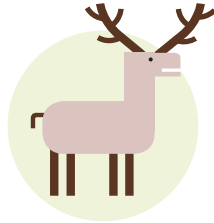

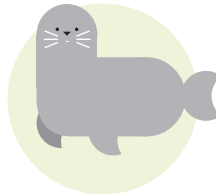

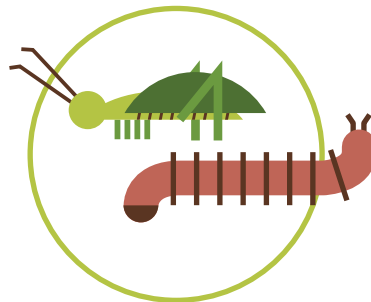
THE MOST THREATENED SPECIES OF 2017



THE NORTH AMERICAN ASH TREE

CAUSE:

emerald ash borer, an invasive Asian beetle.



MADAGASCAR GRASSHOPPER AND MILLIPEDE

CAUSE:

degradation of their habitat due to the extraction of wood, grazing, and mining.



THE AFRICAN ANTELOPE

CAUSE:

disappearance of their habitat due to human occupation and climate change.



SNOW LEOPARD

CAUSE:

reduction in their habitat due to human pressures.
