



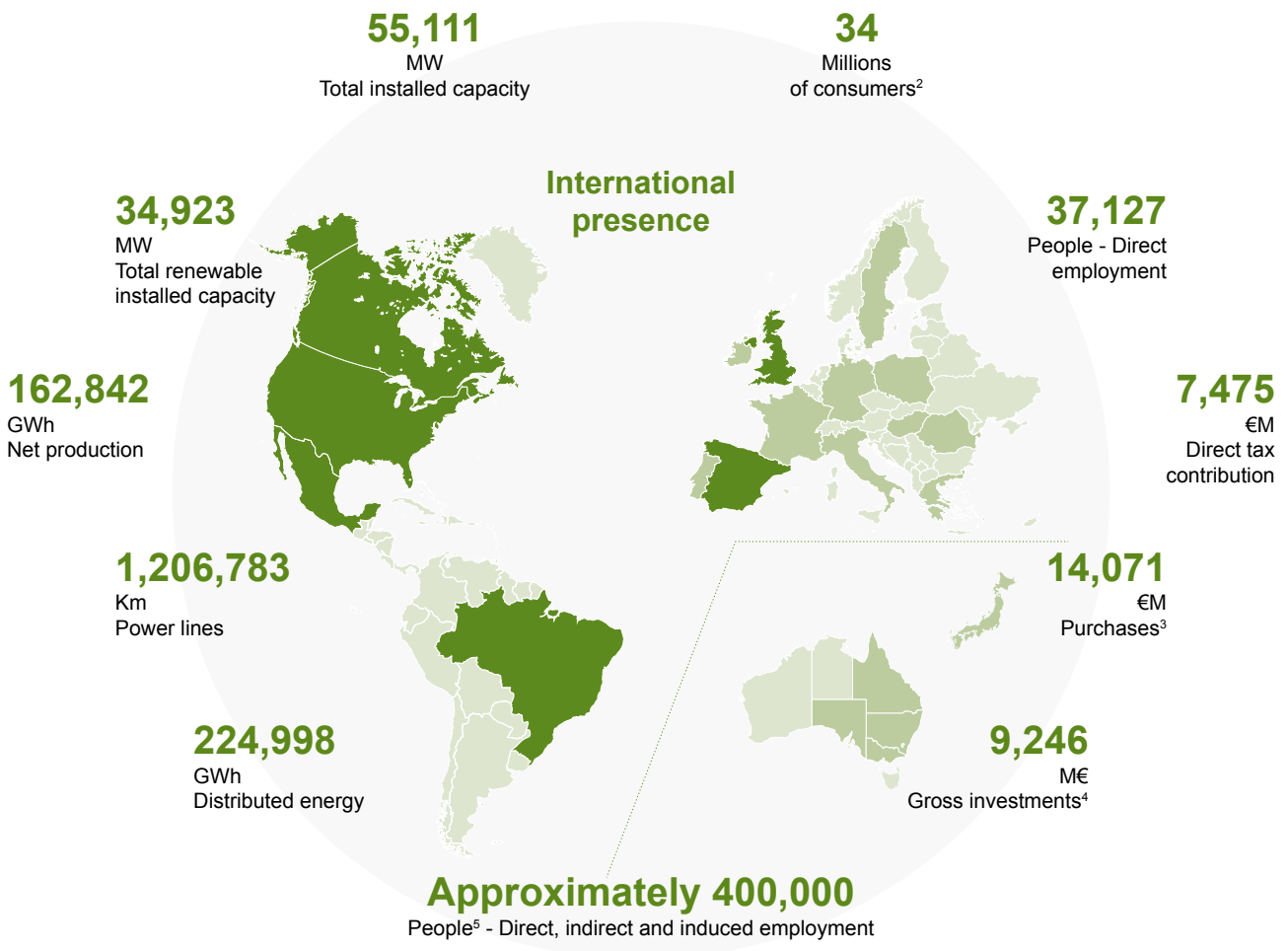
1.1 The utility of the future
